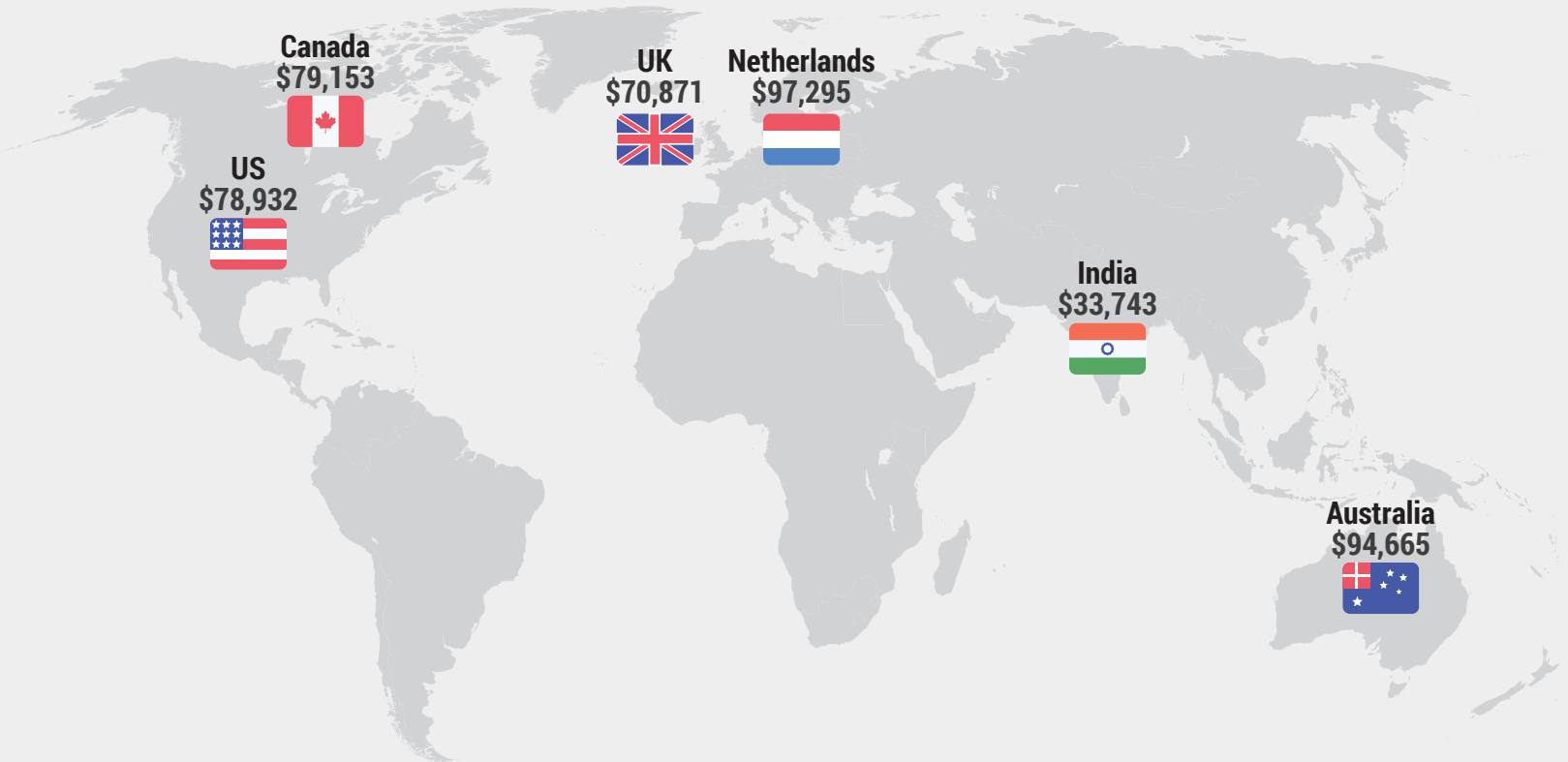


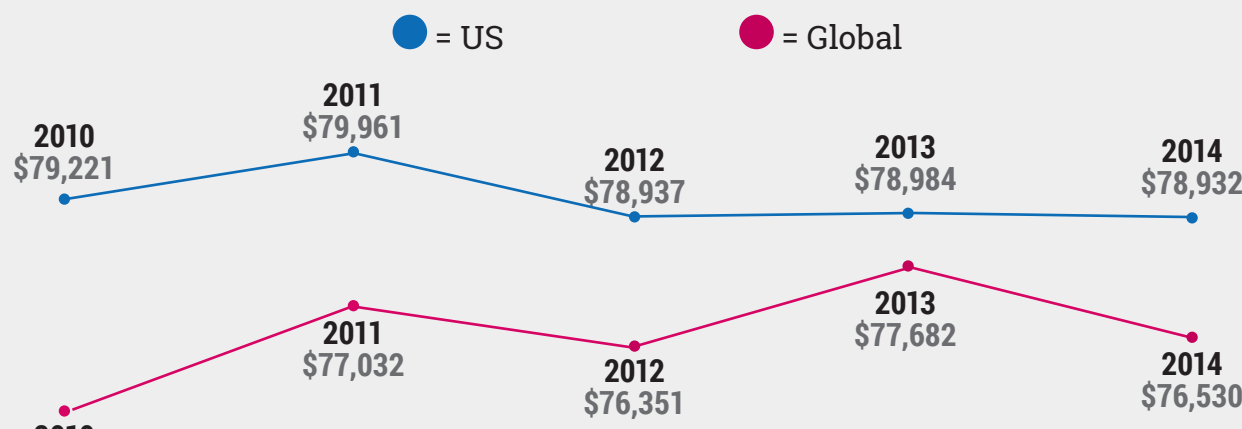

2014 Country Salary Averages

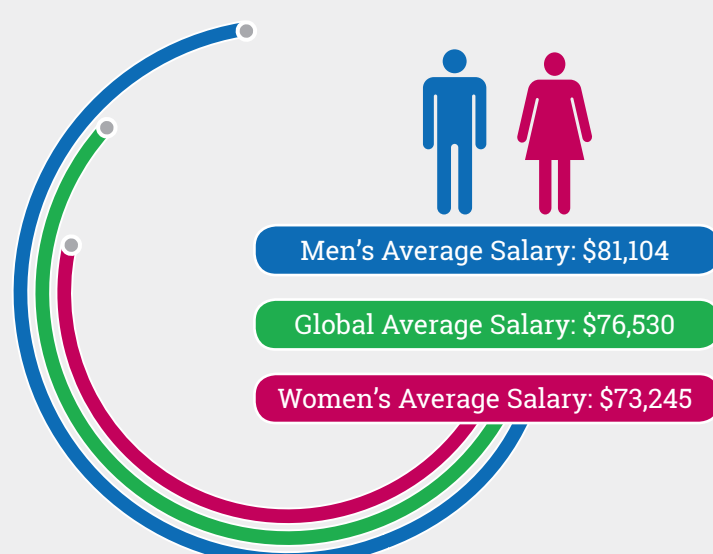
The report shows all salaries in US dollars (USD) in order to use a common currency throughout.

Women's salaries are 9.7% lower, on average, than men's and 4.4% lower than the average global salary.



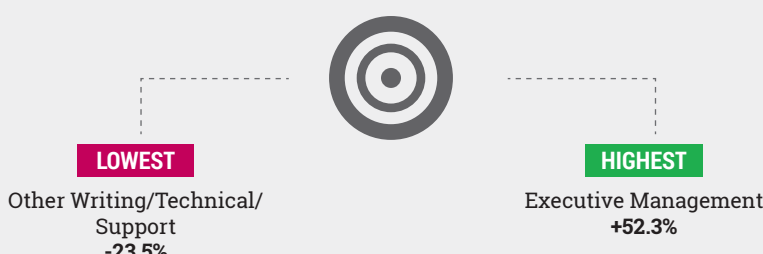

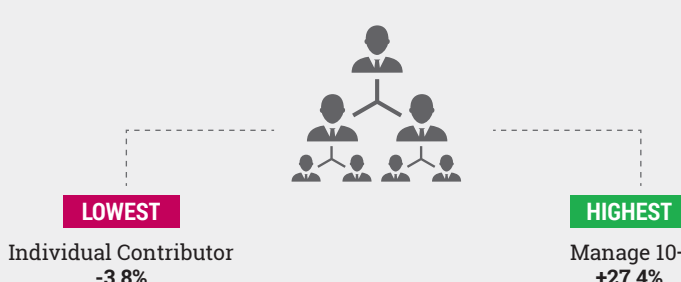
