





The Partnership for 21st Century Skills includes members who represent K-12 education. Since Partnership introduced this vision in 2002, many other advocates of young people and American workers, including youth development and afterschool groups, library and media specialists, educational technology experts, and adult education and workforce development professionals, have found that it can be used as a guiding framework for their work.

> Higher education institutions need to actively work with industry leaders and business partners to understand the skills gaps. Together they can then shape and continually tune curricula to meet both accreditation requirements and business needs. 
Can We Fix The Skills Gap?

> We're talking less about K-12 education and more about K-Gray education, kindergarten to retirement.




